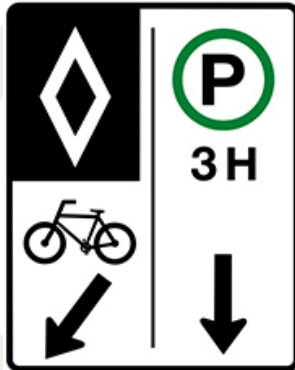


Bike Lane Regulations

(By-Law 2014-059)

The Municipality of Clarington has dedicated bike lanes in various urban areas. Signs and pavement markings indicate these areas are for cyclist use only.

Clarington's Traffic By-law (2014-059) states there is **NO STOPPING** and **NO PARKING** in bike lanes. Vehicles cannot drive in these lanes.



Where road-width allows, we have also created on-street parking beside the bike lanes as shown in the photo to the left.

Vehicles can **ONLY** park in the right designated lane for three hours. The Bike Lane beside it, is for cyclists only.

Our roads are a public space to be shared by everyone including vehicles, pedestrians, assisted-mobility users, cyclists and e-bike users. To ensure public safety, use the designated lanes appropriately.
